3. The patient/client will wear lower-body undergarments: boxers or briefs for men, panties for women.
4. Sexual advances of any kind will not be tolerated and the patient/client will be asked to leave immediately. Further the patient/client will not be rescheduled or referred to another massage therapist.
5. Payment is expected as services are rendered.
